Buchanan Scrubbing the Ohio Democracy.

Prof. Alexander Dimitry, whom Mr. Buchanan has recently appointed Minister to Nicaragua, "is reported to be of African descent," in part, and could not be a voter, or eligible to office in this State, according to the Democratic law of last winter.
