On Saturday last, the President, accompanied by the Secretary of the navy, Com. Rogers, Com. Morris, and several members of Congress, paid a visit to the U. S. ship of the line, North Carolina, lying at anchor in the Potomac, off Ragged Point. Upon the arrival of the President on board, the crew gave 3 hearty cheers and a grand salute was fired. On Sunday morning, divine service was performed on board before the visitors. The officers and seamen of the ship, in number 960, manifested profound attention. She has a well selected library of 1100 volumes.— This vessel mounts 90 guns and is pierced for 102.
